*A carbon zero school is one that, on its site and through all its activities and procurement, does not contribute to climate change through carbon emissions.*

### Why sign up and take part?

- Join a national network of schools and sustainability organisations sharing information about how to get to zero carbon, and working together with local councils and government to make it happen
- Schools account for 10-20% of public sector emissions. Reducing this can make a significant impact to UK-wide targets of reaching net-zero, helping us safeguard the planet for future generations
- By responding to young people's calls for action, schools can be trailblazers for their community. They can be the spark for community action, encouraging more people to take action in their everyday lives to help tackle the climate crisis
- Taking action on carbon will benefit your school community directly in many ways: lower energy bills; cleaner air; healthier school food; more comfortable buildings in which to learn; job creation in your local community
- Engaging children and young people will provide them with a positive sense of action about the climate emergency.

**Schools can be community leaders in reducing carbon - and hundreds of them already are.**

### How are schools taking action to cut carbon?

- There are seven key impact areas that schools are working across to cut carbon: energy use, travel, waste, water, food, procurement and school grounds.
